

eTwinning Seminar for teachers experienced in teaching (newly arrived) migrant children

In all European education systems there is an increasing proportion of students with a migration background. The successful integration of these children in European schools and societies is both an economic necessity and a pre-condition for democratic stability and for social cohesion.

Teachers play a vital role in this process and there is an urgent need for more knowledge sharing on the nature and effectiveness of integration approaches.

The eTwinning seminar will give teachers who work with refugee and migrant children in different European countries the opportunity to share experiences and to develop eTwinning projects involving pupils of their classes.

The seminar is associated to the International Conference of the German Pedagogical Exchange Service »Migration – Integration. Schools manage diversity!«

Participants will have the chance to benefit from the thematic input of many initiatives working on how to promote democratic citizenships, human rights, mutual respect and tolerance in schools.

One of the declared aims of the conference is to give examples on how international school cooperation in exchange programmes such as the EU programme Erasmus+ can be used to support common learning processes and the integration of the young refugees into school and society.

Special attention will be devoted to innovative teaching methods in teacher training and in classes and to the promotion of tolerance and democratic values through school partnership programmes in Europe and worldwide.

Target group: Secondary teachers of all subjects and any type of school (pupils aged 10-19) interested in starting eTwinning projects related to the topic.

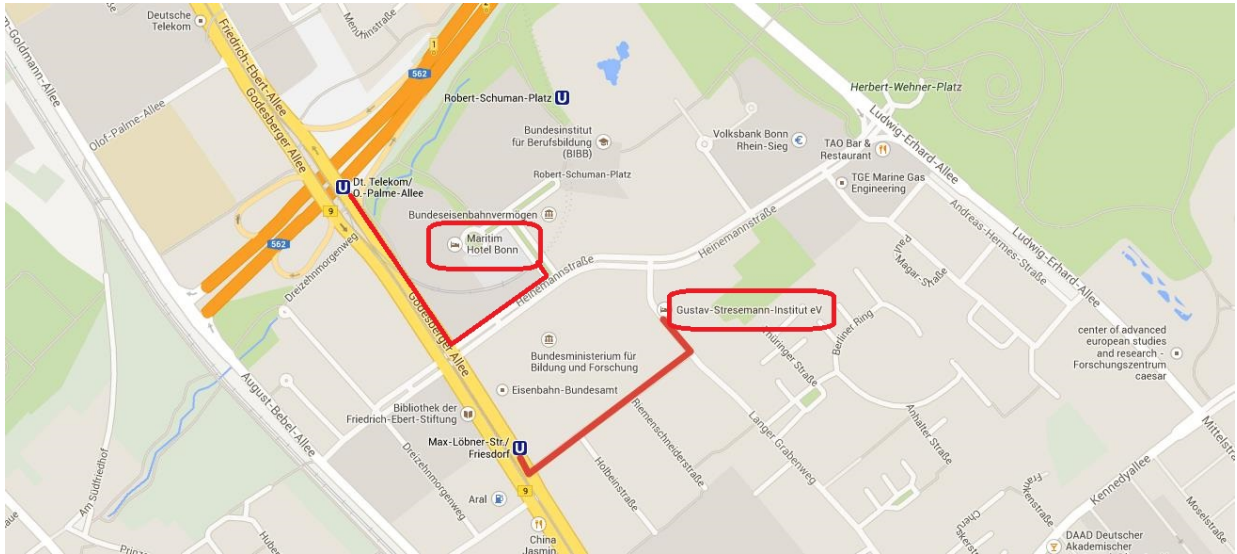

How to get there by bus and rail

Take bus No. SB 60 to Bonn Central Station (Hauptbahnhof). Change there to the underground station and take either underground/tram line 16 or 63 in the direction Bad Godesberg.

Trams commute every 7 minutes between Bonn Central Station and Bad Godesberg. Travel time is about 10 minutes.

Get off at “Max-Löbner-Straße” and turn left on leaving the tram stop, then cross the street. Walk down Max-Löbner-Straße to the end and then turn left into Langer Grabenweg. You will find the hotel after about 50 meters on your right hand side.

Tickets

For trips with the shuttle bus No. SB60 between Cologne Bonn Airport and Bonn City, you will need a ticket at price level 4 (7,70 €).

For trips within Bonn city centre, tickets at price level 1b (2,80 €) are sufficient. In case you plan to use public transport more often, you may also check multi-trip tickets covering four rides.

Tickets can either be bought on board or at a ticket vending machine.
