

Submitting blog articles on EPALÉ is easy as 1- 2-3.
Just follow these simple steps:



THINK IT
STEP 1

Choose an interesting topic, relevant to adult learning.



WRITE IT
STEP 2

Write your blog post. Be creative and don't be afraid to think outside the box.



CHECK IT
STEP 3

Check that your post follows the editorial policy on the About page.



HAVE IT APPROVED
STEP 5

When approved by the EPALÉ team, your article will be published on the platform!



SUBMIT IT
STEP 4

Click "Suggest a blog post" in the Blog section to submit your post.

Submitting news items on EPALE is easy as 1- 2-3.
Just follow these simple steps:

LOOK IT UP STEP 1

Make sure the news article is not already on EPALE.

WRITE IT STEP 2

Re-tell the story in your own words and credit your source.

Check that your post follows the editorial policy on the About page.

CHECK IT STEP 3

SUBMIT IT STEP 4

Click "Suggest an article" in the News section to submit your news item.

HAVE IT APPROVED STEP 5

When approved by the EPALE team, your article will be published on the platform!

HOW TO ADD A RESOURCE TO EPALE

Sharing your resources on EPALE is easy as 1- 2-3.
Just follow these simple steps:



LOOK IT UP
STEP 1

Ensure the resource is not already uploaded by using the search function in the resource section.

CLICK IT
STEP 2

Click 'propose a new resource'.

Describe the type of resource and an outline its contents.

CHECK IT
STEP 3

SUBMIT IT
STEP 4

Upload or link to the resource.

HAVE IT APPROVED
STEP 5

When approved by the EPALE team your resource will appear on the platform.

LOOK IT UP STEP 1

Make sure the event is not already in the Event section.



DESCRIBE IT STEP 2

Click "Suggest an event" and fill in all the required fields



QUALITY CHECK IT STEP 3

Make sure you've completed all the required fields and your entries are correct.



HAVE IT APPROVED STEP 4

When approved by the EPALE team, your event will be published on the platform!




