Transnational activities in which organisations can offer new and exciting learning experiences for young people and youth workers.

## Youth Worker Mobility



Supports the professional development of youth workers. It can enable youth workers to attend seminars and training courses.

Job shadowing or observation periods in a youth organisation abroad are also possible. Duration is from two to 12 months (excluding travel time).

## European Voluntary Service



Is for young people usually aged 18-30 to volunteer in another country for two to 12 months (or shorter in the case of young people with fewer opportunities).

Organisations can participate as Sending Organisations, supporting their young people before, during and after their volunteering experience; or as Receiving Organisations that must provide a varied programme of work as well as a mentor and a supervisor for volunteers. All organisations involved in EVS must be accredited by their National Agency before applying.

## Youth Exchange



Youth Exchanges are group activities involving young people from two or more countries to live and learn together for five to 21 days. Young people aged 13-30 can take part, along with their youth workers/leaders. The minimum number of participants in a youth exchange is 16 and the maximum is 60. There must be at least four young people per group and leaders must be 18 years or older.
