

A roadmap to **Erasmus+** Partnerships for Cooperation funding

Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe. In Ireland, organisations can apply for Erasmus+ funding through Léargas to undertake 2 types of projects.



You need to be formally constituted as an organisation or company to

apply for Erasmus funding. If you're working with groups of young people, check out our Mobility Projects or European Solidarity Corps.



and receive either €30,000 or €60,000 funding. With lower entry or output requirements, they can be a good entry point to Erasmus+ funding and help you plan for a bigger application down the line.

€120,000. This requires a minimum of 3 partners and carries more expectations in terms of outputs and impact than Small-scale Partnerships.

€400,000. Bigger projects have a minimum of 3 partners and require extensive applications. They can be more ambitious in terms of reach, project archives and outputs.
