## WHAT IS THE EUROPEAN DAY OF LANGUAGES?

The European Day of Languages is an annual initiative launched by the Council of Europe together with the European Commission in 2001. It is celebrated every year on 26 September and aims to promote linguistic and cultural diversity in Europe.

The main aims of the Day are to raise public awareness of the importance of language learning, to highlight all the languages spoken in Europe and to promote multilingualism. It also aims to encourage intercultural dialogue and strengthen mutual understanding between different cultures and language communities. Languages are much more than simple means of communication. They are living witnesses to the history, culture and identity of each people.

Each year, the European Centre for Modern Languages (ECML) chooses a theme for the Day. To celebrate the 25th anniversary of the European Day of Languages, the slogan "Languages open hearts and minds" is proposed, reflecting the fact that language learning involves both the emotions and the brain. As well as improving cognitive skills and providing a bridge to connect people, language learning facilitates the exchange of ideas, emotions and experiences, building empathy and respect for different ways of life.


#### **SELF-EVALUATE YOUR LANGUAGE SKILLS**

#### "LINGUINE" LANGUAGE BOARD GAME

"Linguine" is a fun, educational board game created to celebrate the European Day of Languages. The name comes from the Italian word, literally meaning "little tongues", reflecting long, flat, ribbon-like shape of linguine, that resemble thin tongues.

The game seeks to test players' knowledge of the many and varied languages native to the continent of Europe. Linguistic diversity enriches communication and culture, just as culinary diversity does with food! The game is primarily designed to be played in a classroom setting.

Working together in teams, players advance on their journey by answering questions and taking challenges about languages.

#### LARA'S LANGUAGE JOURNEYS

The languages you will encounter in this booklet reflect the diversity of the cultures and traditions which exist side by side on our continent. Some of the around 225 languages which are native to Europe are spoken by millions and others are spoken only by a handful of people. During this short journey, you will discover lots of similarities. You will also find out about their differences. All have a unique identity and their own story to tell!

Having found out about some 46 of Europe's mostly 'bigger' languages on her first journey, on this trip Lara chooses, on a new trip, to explore languages which are not so well known beyond the areas they are spoken in. In some cases the languages she encounters have several dialects, some do not have a standardised written form or can be rendered in different scripts and in many cases the numbers of native speakers are declining.

Also listen to how these languages sound! Download a language tree poster. There are a wide variety of suggestions for teachers on how to use these booklets.

## THE LANGUAGE CHALLENGE APP AND HANDBOOK
