Below you will find useful information to help you plan your journey to Dublin and your transfer to Malahide.

Arrival in Dublin

- Dublin Airport is Ireland's main international airport, and it is located just a short distance from Malahide.

Transport from Airport

- Malahide is conveniently located approximately 10–15 minutes from Dublin Airport, making transfers quick and straightforward.

Taxi

Taxis are readily available 24/7 directly outside Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 arrivals at Dublin Airport, with dedicated, signposted ranks.

Taxi ride from the airport to The Grand Hotel Malahide takes approx. 10–15 minutes to, depending on traffic, **expect €20 - €35 cost.**

Public transport

Dublin Bus



Bus 102 Timetable: [Link to Timetable](#)

- The bus 102 will take you directly to Malahide, takes 40 minutes.
- The stop is 'Malahide' just 5 min walk from the Grand Hotel.
- The 102 bus departs from Zone 15 at T1 Dublin Airport. Operates approximately every 30 minutes.
- **NB:** You **cannot pay** with credit or debit cards on the bus. You can only pay using **cash (exact change)** or a **leap card**.

Leap Card

- A reusable travel card for public transport can be purchased at Airport Kiosks for €5, which can then be topped up as needed.

Time zone

- Ireland operates on Irish Standard Time (IST) UTC +1 in October.

Electrical plugs

- Type G (same as UK), Voltage: 230V

Local Currency

- Euro (€), credit/debit cards widely accepted

Weather

- Average temperature: 10–15°C ([Weather Forecast](#))
- Expect some rain – a light waterproof jacket is recommended

Connolly Hospital Blanchardstown

Address: Mill Road, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15

Type: General hospital with Emergency Department

Travel time: approx. 20 minutes by car

- The city also offers excellent restaurants, traditional music, and beautiful coastal walks.

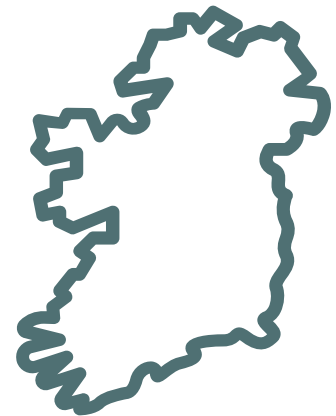

Getting around

- Best way to get to the city centre from Malahide is by DART (train service) which takes around 30 minutes.
- The city centre stops are Connolly, Tara Street and Pearse Street.
- Tickets can be purchased at train stops, or you can use a Leap Card instead.



Useful Irish Phrases

While English is the main language spoken, Irish (Gaeilge) is Ireland's first official language. Here are some useful words and phrases you might want to try out during the trip:

Greetings

- Dia dhuit (dee-ah gwit) – Hello
- Dia is Muire dhuit (dee-ah iss mwir-eh gwit) – Hello (reply)
- Slán (slawn) – Goodbye
- Le do thoil (leh duh hull) – Please
- Go raibh maith agat (guh rev mah ah-gut) – Thank you
- Tá fáilte romhat (taw fall-cha row-ut) – You're welcome
- Gabh mo leithscéal (gow muh lehsh-kayl) – Excuse me / Sorry



Cultural English Phrases

- I'm Grand - Not bad/OK
- Craic - Fun
 - Any craic? - How are you?
- Howaya - Hello
- The Jacks - Bathrooms
- Stall the Ball - to slow down
- Sound As A Pound - all is well
- I'm Absolutely Stuffed - full appetite
